

MINKEE

COIN

BABY

QUILT

Materials:

- 1 Charm Pack (42 5" Squares)
- 12 Coordinating Minkee Charm Squares
- $\frac{3}{4}$ yd Fabric for Sashing
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yd Fabric for Border
- 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yd Fabric for Backing
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yd Fabric for Binding



CHARM SQUARES: Cut the 42 squares in half to make eighty-four 2 ½ x 5" rectangles.

MINKEE: Trim the 12 coordinating Minkee squares to 4 ½ x 5" rectangles.

SASHING: Cut eight 2 ½" x WOF strips.

OUTER BORDER: Cut five 3 ½" x WOF strips.

BINDING: Cut six 2 ½" x WOF strips.

1. Assemble charm squares as you normally would for a coin quilt but randomly add in 2 to 3 Minkee rectangles for each of the 5 strips.
Hint: I combined charm squares into blocks of 4 and 6 coins then attached a Minkee square. Doing this means there will be 16 small rectangles in a strip that has 3 Minkee rectangles and 18 small rectangles in a strip that has 2 Minkee rectangles.
2. Add sashing strips between the coin strips and then to the top and bottom.
Hint: Be careful not to pull on the strips as the minkee is very stretchy.
3. Attach the outer border.
4. Backing fabric is large enough that piecing is not necessary. After it is quilted attach binding.
